**British Motorcycle Preservation Society (BMPS) 40<sup>th</sup> year Celebration Show at Glyndywfry Station near Corwen 1<sup>st</sup> / 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2017 by kind permission of Llangollen Railway at the Classic Transport Weekend**

It was agreed at the February 2017 Club Committee meeting that this year's show would be held at this location to celebrate our 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. Members were informed of this decision at the April, May and June meetings. Peter Fogg and Len Ferneyhough had met with the Llangollen Railway who were anxious to increase the number of bike entries attending this event. They gave the go ahead for this section of their show to be run by the BMPS. They would give the Club support by including us in their advertising and promotion of the BMPS in their show brochure. There would be no charges in using this site. It was agreed that donations would be taken for Air Ambulance.



**Sat 1<sup>st</sup> July**

The wet weather from Friday had blown over and the show ground filled with old buses (25), cars (150), some trucks and motorcycles (70). There were some interesting Club member's bikes and some Caernarfon members attended and the passing steam trains were an added attraction.

**Sun 2<sup>nd</sup> July**

Excellent weather - shorts and tee shirts!! Some 150 bikes attending with more than half were classic bikes?? The show area was continually being extended to accommodate the numbers attending. Entrants were been given free bus/train passes and were seen to be enjoying the drive by bus to Corwen or the ride by train to Llangollen and return. The BMPS Show awards were presented albeit only a small number of club members attended! The VMCC Members M L Weaver and W C Hamilton judged the Club bikes and our Chairman Gordon and Len Ferneyhough selected the visitor's awards.

6 new members signed up to BMPS at the Show. The Charity collection to Air Ambulance raised £171. Sincere thanks to Peter, Len and Lin for all their efforts in organising this event.
